La Trappe Bockbier Trappist (7%, 11.2oz.) \$9 (BEL) The only bock beer made by monks in the world.

Bronx Brewery Winter Pale Ale (6.7% 16oz.) \$7 (NY) Pale ale brewed with molasses, ginger, cloves and cinnamon.

Veltins Pilsner (5%, .5/1L) \$7/\$13 (GER) Crisp, clean, classic German pilsner.

Reissdorf Kölsch (4.8%, 400ml) \$7 (GER) Subtle pale malts, clean and refreshing. Perfect kölsch.

Founders Oatmeal Stout (Nitro) (5%, 16oz.) \$7 (MI) Designed and created by Midwest sexual legend, Ryan Mcgaffigan. His mind was open to some of the most groundbreaking bedroom moves of his generation and he was just as instinctive and bold in the brewery. We tip our hat and thank you for all you have contributed to American culture.

Half Acre Daisy Cutter Pale Ale (5.2% 16oz) \$7 (IL) Delicious pale ale from Chicago. A 98% on ratebeer.com. Also the adopted name of a bomb used by the USA in Vietnam and Afghanistan. The nickname 'Daisy Cutter' was coined for the bombs ability to "flatten a section of forest into a helicopter landing zone".

Other Half IPA (7.1% 16oz.) \$8 (NY) Stupid good beer from the best brewery in Brooklyn, NY.

Bells Two Hearted Ale IPA (7%, 16oz.) \$7 (MI) The Ernest Hemmingway of beer.

BELGIAN STYLE

Brasserie dOrval Orval (7.2%, 12oz) \$9 (BEL) Orval Trappist brewery makes only one beer for the general public. It has an intensely aromatic and dry character. Between the first and second fermentations there is also an additional dry-hopping process.

Allagash Tripel Reserve (9%, 12oz.) \$7 (ME) This strong golden ale is marked by passion fruit and herbal notes in the aroma, with suggestions of banana and honey in the complex palate.

La Trappe Quadrupel Trappist Ale (10%, 330ml) \$11 (BEL) After Bane broke Batman's back, he took a seat and knocked back this quad.

Omer Blond Belgian Ale (8%, 330ml.) \$10 (BEL) "Better than Duvel." - Abe Lincoln

St. Feuillien Saison (6.5%, 330ml.) \$8 (**CAN=COOL**) (BEL) Possibly the sexiest beer we carry at Spritzenhaus.

St. Feuillien Grand Cru (9.5%, 330ml.) \$9 (BEL) This extra-blond amber nectar masterpiece undergoes refermentation in the bottle, resulting in a beer endowed with unforgettable character. A perfect Belgian beer.

Kwak Brouwerij Bosteels (8.4 %, 330ml.) \$9 (BEL) Full-bodied Belgian specialty ale. Amber in color with beautiful foam and slightly sweet, seductive malt character. Rich, satisfying Belgian experience from a family run brewery.

Allagash Curieux Tripel (11%, 750ml.) \$33 (ME) Aged in bourbon barrels. Coriander and clove spices.

Duvel (8.5%, 330ml.) \$10 (BEL) See "Omer" description above.

DIGESTIF

Underberg Digestif Bitter (44% 20ml.) \$3 (GER) Kind of like a Fernet shot in a tiny bottle. "For after a good meal." -Hannibal Lecter

BELGIAN ALES

Tripel Karmaliet Brouwerij Bosteels (8.4%, 11.2oz.) \$9 (BEL) Hints of vanilla mixed with banana and citrus. Haus favorite and much better than Duvel.

-SOUR-

Cuvee des Jacobins (5.5%, 11.2oz.) \$12 (BEL) Unblended old lambic, aged for 18 months in French oak barrels from the cognac region. Full body with overtones of vanilla, dried cherry, stone fruit and cocoa. It is a complex, delicious sour beer.

WHEATS

Schneider Brooklyn Hopfen Weisse (8.2%, 500ml.) \$12 (GER) Crisp hops with really strong citrusy flavors at the same time. Rising booziness at the finish. Really nice.

Schneider Aventinus Doppelbock (8.2%, 500ml.) \$12 (GER) Belgian yeast, clove, caramelized banana, brown sugar.

Hitachino Nest White (5%, 11oz.) \$9 (JAP) Belgian style with coriander, nutmeg, and orange juice.

Hitachino Nest Saison du Japon (5%, 11oz.) \$9 (JAP) Saison du Japon is brewed with a local wheat and malted rice which is a vital ingredient to create Sake.
